


## **Building a Proposal**

- Identify target audience and stakeholders








#### **Pilot Project**


- July 2018
- 80 devices from Friends of the Fort Worth Library
- Four locations with 20 each
- 6 month funding

#### **Expansion Project**

- September 2018
- 120 devices from City of Fort Worth ITS
- Added 4 more locations

## **Specifics**

- Franklin Wireless R910 / Pocket WiFi
  - Sprint network
  - 10 devices can connect at one time
  - Unlimited data but does throttle down
  - Not charged for physical device
  - Data is around \$360/device/year
- No overdue fines or replacement costs
- We're not charged for lost devices







## Marketing to the Public

- Hotspot launch
- News outlets
- Test families
- Community outreach
  - Fliers/Social Media











### Circulation considerations

- Packaging (and branding and donor acknowledgment)
- User agreement? (no)
- Which borrowers?
  - Adults, Youth, Nonresidents, TexShare, MetrOPAC, Temporary, etc.
- Holds?
  - Any qualified cardholder can hold and checkout; must pickup at assigned branch
- Renewals? How many times? (Yes, 2)
- Suspend data service if overdue? (Yes, 3 days overdue)
- How long before it's "lost?" (42 days)
- Fines and lost/damage charges? (no and no)





### Issues

- Staff time to keep up with charging, clearing unexpired holds, suspending, unsuspending, general troubleshooting
  - Coordinators were on calls with Sprint 45 minutes to an hour+ troubleshooting
  - Processing staff now suspend overdue hotspots and handle all troubleshooting/Sprint calls
  - Circ procedure fix—Processing suspends them, places "reactivate" note in the item record --> Pop-up alert at checkin
- Poor service in some areas that worked previously (5G?)
- Patrons mix devices and cases (so wrong ones are suspended)
- Patrons reset the devices to factory defaults (bye bye passwords and network info)
- Different models (end of life)
- Chargers
  - Patrons tend to keep them
  - Different USB forms for different models



## **Statistics**

- Current number: 200
- Current holds: 385 (adding about 7 holds a day)
- Lifetime circ: 1,724
  - Adults: 1,255
  - Youth: 373
  - Staff: 96
- Number suspended 3+ days overdue: 33
- Number lost: 5
- Number not working: 10
