


HUBBARD DINING HALL shortly before Governor Allan Shivers came to the TSCW campus to deliver the main address at the dedication of the new dining hall on May 12. A \$1,500,000 unit, the main floor includes four student dining rooms, each with a seating capacity of approximately 500, two banquet rooms and a cafeteria, plus the centrally located kitchen and two lounges. On the lower floor, a storeroom, bakery, meat shop, room for frozen food and laundry supply the huge unit and eliminate delivery service. Two of the dining rooms, the cafeteria and the banquet rooms will be airconditioned. The structure is 300 feet, a city block, square.









ACCLAIMED FOR THE fourteenth year in succession the most impressive dramatic production on the TSCW campus, The Nativity Pageant, by President L. H. Hubbard, was presented again in 1950 to climax the Christmas season.

Inspired by Mexican Yuletide festivals in Juarez during his boyhood, President Hubbard introduced the pageant that has become a tradition to his girls. Using the titles of Renaissance biblical paintings for the nine scenes in his original drama, President Hubbard wrote a story that critics have

judged unique for the wisdom that it attributes to Mary. The dramatization reflects the author's belief that Jesus learned from his mother many of the things he later taught his followers.




