What are Open Educational Resources (OER)?



Teaching and learning resources that are in the public domain or have been released under an intellectual property license that permits the free use, adaptation, and redistribution.

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OER Development and Implementation Grants

Development Grants:

- matching grants of up to \$25,000
- support faculty teams in developing new OER for online course delivery
- cross-institutional collaboration is required

Implementation Grants:

- matching grants of up to \$5,000
- support faculty or teams of faculty in the redesign of courses for online delivery using existing OER
- cross-institutional collaboration is encouraged

Special grant requirements:

- core-curriculum courses, co-requisite courses, and Workforce Education Course Manual
- developed for online delivery
- no cost for students
- must be taught using **only** OER for at least two terms



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Support for faculty concerning OER adoptions and development of ideas and materials

One-on-one consultations:

Content development, existing resources check, graphics and layout help, video.
