## The Program

Designed in 1978 specifically for practicing librarians and others who are unable to participate in library education programs at traditional times, GRASP (Graduate Regional Accelerated Study Program) is offered by the School of Library Science of the Texas Woman's University.

Program goals include:

- Providing continuing education courses for practicing librarians
- Scheduling courses at times compatible with fulltime employment
- Offering courses accessible to participants who live outside the North Central Texas region

Each course offered in the Spring 1980 Semester is worth three (3) credit hours. Courses will be taught on alternating Saturdays to enable participants to complete six (6) hours of credit.

## The School of Library Science

The School of Library Science at the Texas Woman's University is the oldest continuously ALA-accredited library school in the Southwest. Undergraduate, master's and doctoral programs are offered by a faculty including scholars in library science, library administration, library automation, school librarianship and many other specializations.

The School maintains a library of 20,000 volumes, subscribes to more than 100 journals and provides numerous other specially acquired materials in support of the library science curriculum.

For students attending courses on the main University campus in Denton the University provides a bookstore, student union, health center, other educational and recreational facilities, and housing for participants requiring overnight accommodations.
